Allison Fagin is the CCHS STAR student and she chose Ms. Dana Cook as her STAR Teacher.

The Student Teacher Achievement Recognition (STAR) program honors Georgia's highest achieving high school seniors and teachers who were most instrumental in their academic development. To obtain the STAR nomination, high school seniors must have the highest score on any single test date of the three-part SAT taken through the November test date of their senior year and be in the top 10 percent or top 10 students of their class based on grade point average. Each high school STAR student is asked to name his/her STAR teacher. High school STAR Students compete for system titles; system STAR students in turn compete for region-wide honors in the 12 STAR Regions. Region winners and their STAR teachers are invited to Atlanta to compete for the state STAR scholarships and awards.

# Looking for Scholarships?

When you are planning to go to college, things can be financially difficult. Maybe what can benefit you are the blessings of a scholarship. One of the many scholarships offered and one of the most popular is the HOPE scholarship. To be awarded the HOPE scholarship, a student has to graduate with at least a 3.0 grade point average from an eligible high school.

A student must be enrolled as a degree-seeking student at a public or private high school. The school has to be HOPE eligible for a college or university in Georgia. There are state program requirements, too. The student has to be a U.S citizen or has to be eligible for non-citizen requirements. The student has to be a Georgia legal resident, and be registered with Selective Service. Students have to meet satisfactory academic progress and not be in default or owe a refund from a student financial program.
